This meeting covered many pressing issues concerning the changes in the US depository system, rapid movement from paper to electronic documents, progress of the California state library to maintain the distribution of state documents and act as the regional depository for federal documents, and lay the groundwork for closely working with CDC and SOPAG to preserve our legacy collections and preserve our depository status.
