Current Funding Situation



- **Unstable**

- Anxiety surfaces every 4 years
- Throughout the years: approached by various publishers
- Explored various scenarios with different publishers

Current OA Models: Gold



- Gold Open Access:
 - APCs (Article Processing Charges)
 - Have authors pay APCs?
 - Have universities/libraries pay APCs?

Current OA Models: Green



- Green Open access
 - 1 year “embargo” for 1st year after publication
 - Authors can upload accepted papers to own websites or university repositories

Proposed Trial Model



- Joint ownership* with publisher
- We provide Managing Editor
- They provide copyeditors, webhosting, ScholarOne, marketing
- Minimal APC if author's institution doesn't have provisions to pay APC**
