FINDING BOOKS

Search for books and other materials (such as university publications) on Pegasus [<http://pegasus.library.ucsb.edu>], using “key” words describing your topic in Keyword searches (leave out words like *the, an, of, in, for, etc.*).

Examples:

environmental impact university
universit* sustain*

(use * for alternate word endings: *sustain** retrieves *sustain, sustains, sustainable, sustainability*, etc.)
