Most publications are located in the Government Information Center of the Library.

The UCSB Library is a federal depository, and collects technical reports from several federal agencies. We have been an Atomic Energy Commission depository since 1963; from 1963 – 1996, our reports from AEC, ERDA, and DOE are comprehensive. We have selected reports from NTIS, and access to many NTIS reports from the California State Library. *Most of the collection is not cataloged*; please contact Sherry DeDecker for assistance in locating reports.

- 3. How are the Technical Reports filed?** Technical reports in the GIC are filed three different ways, by Report number, Accession number, or by SuDoc number.
