I. TREATIES TO WHICH THE UNITED STATES IS A PARTY

IDENTIFYING CURRENT TREATIES

The indexes below help identify citations for *published* treaties since 1950. Note that older official treaty series (Bevans, etc) have their own indexes included in the sets. See reverse for sources on *unpublished* treaties.

Treaties in Force [annual] Ref JX 235.9 A3

Identifies all published treaties to which the United States is currently a party. Acts as a good initial subject index to treaties.

Encyclopedia of the United Nations and International Agreements. Ref JX1977 .O8213 1990

Excellent source for identifying general information about treaties.

Current Treaty Index, Ref JX 236.5 C87

Guide to the United States Treaties in Force [annual] Ref JX 236.5 G84

These two indexes update **Treaties in Force** and include treaties not yet officially published.

Westlaw Database: USTREATIES (Available only to UCSB faculty and students) Electronic Arcade

USTREATIES has the text of UST, TIAS and KAV.
