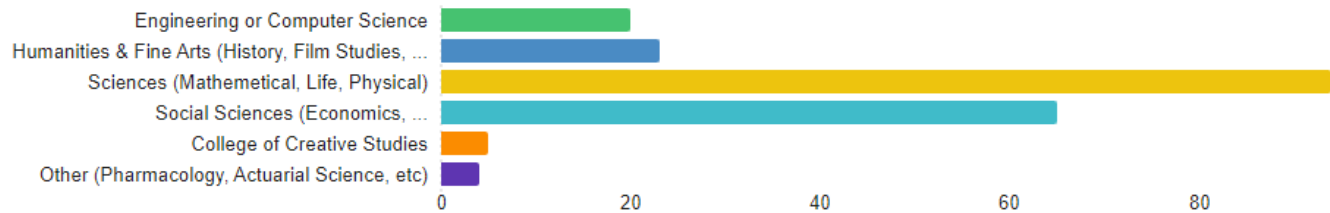

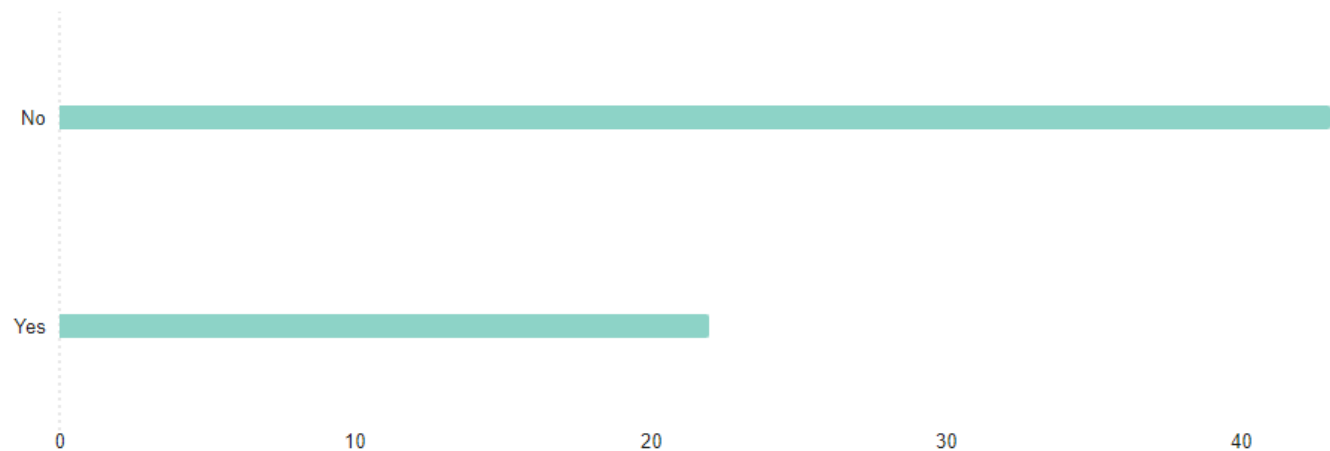
Q1 - Your major is in which of the following divisions? (check all that apply)

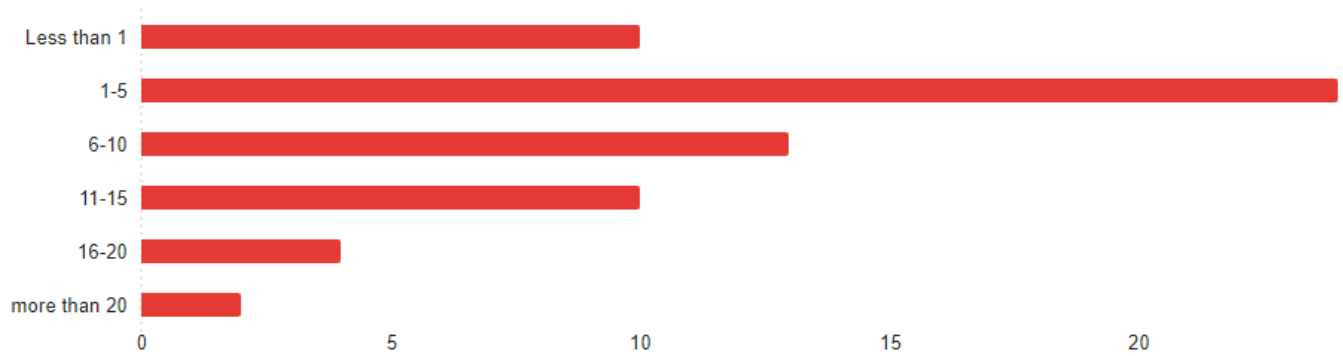
Q2 - Were you a Transfer student?

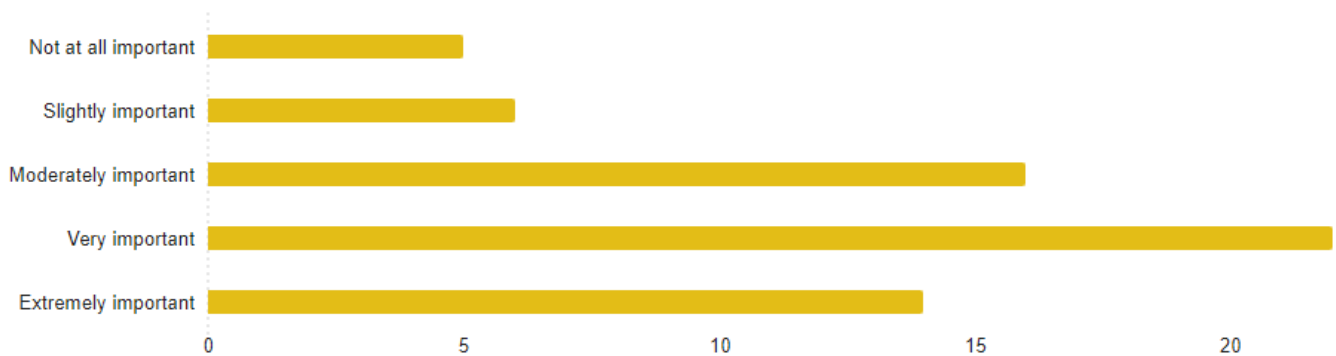
Q3 - On average, how many hours per week did you spend in the Library's physical spaces?

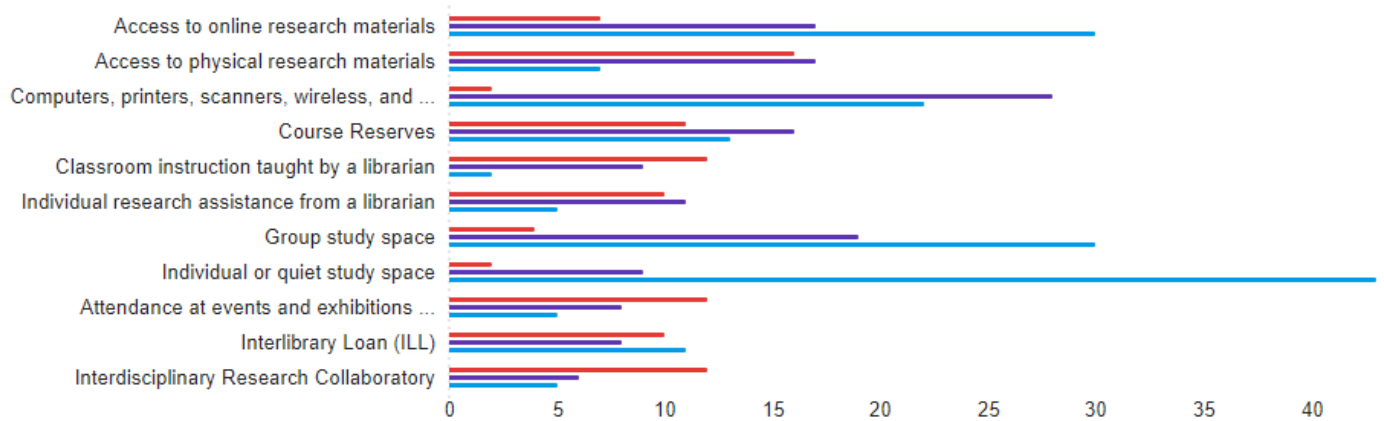
Q4 - On the whole, how important do you feel the Library was to your success at UCSB?
