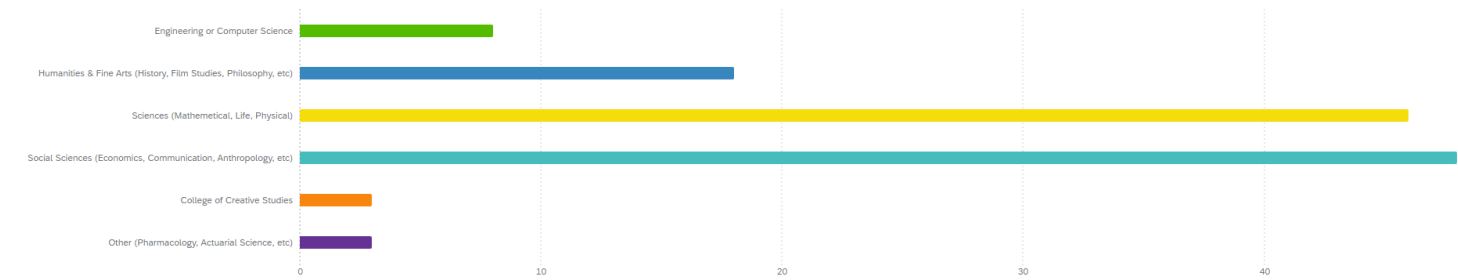

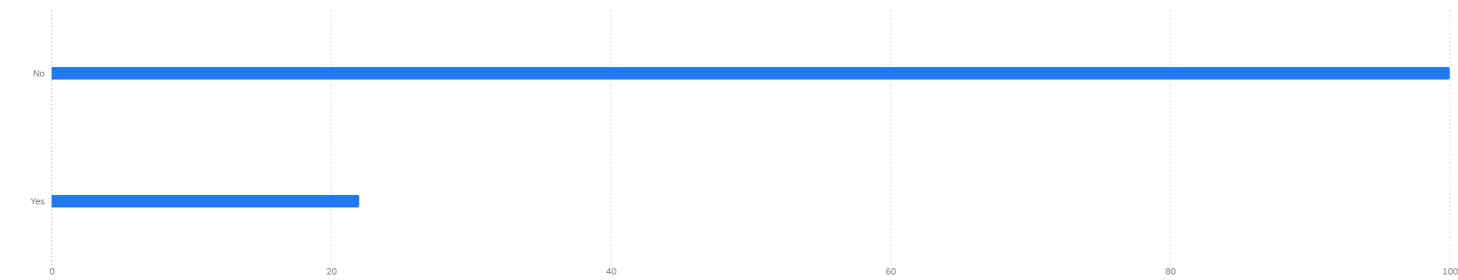

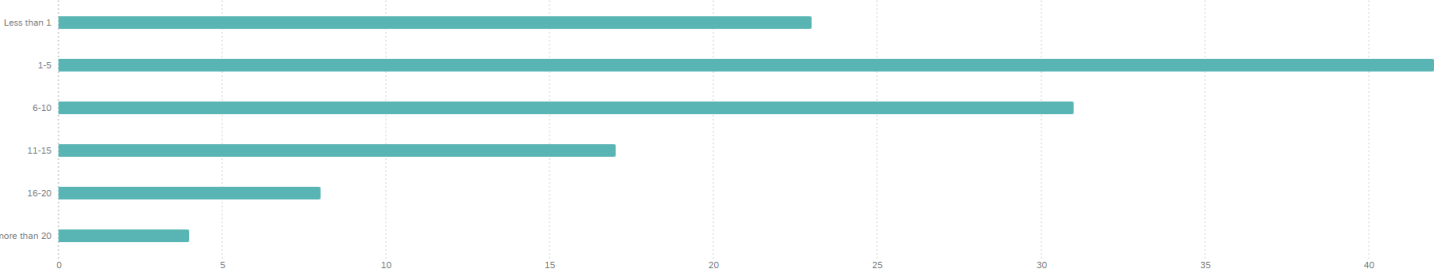

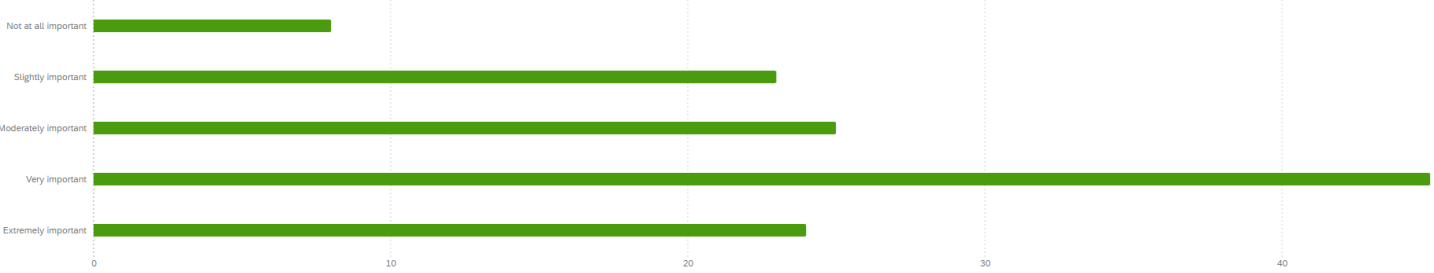
On average, how many hours per week did you spend in the Library's physical spaces? 125 ⓘ

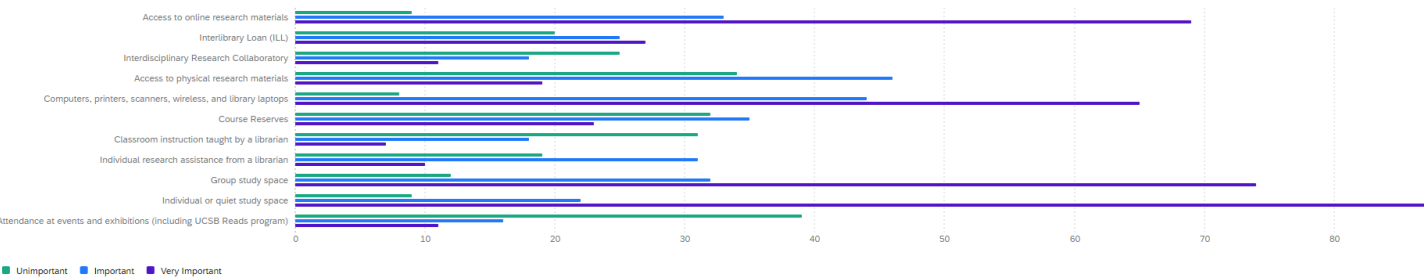
