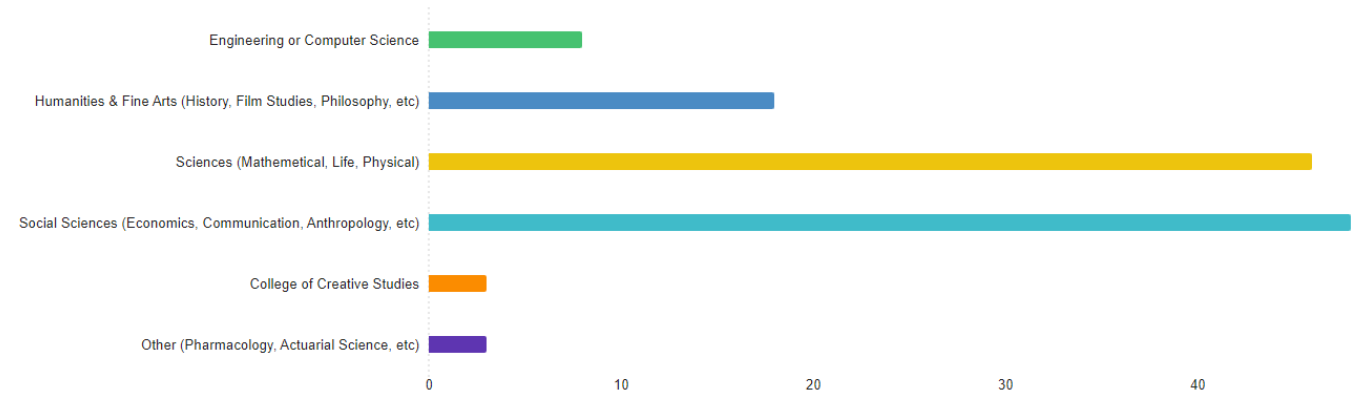

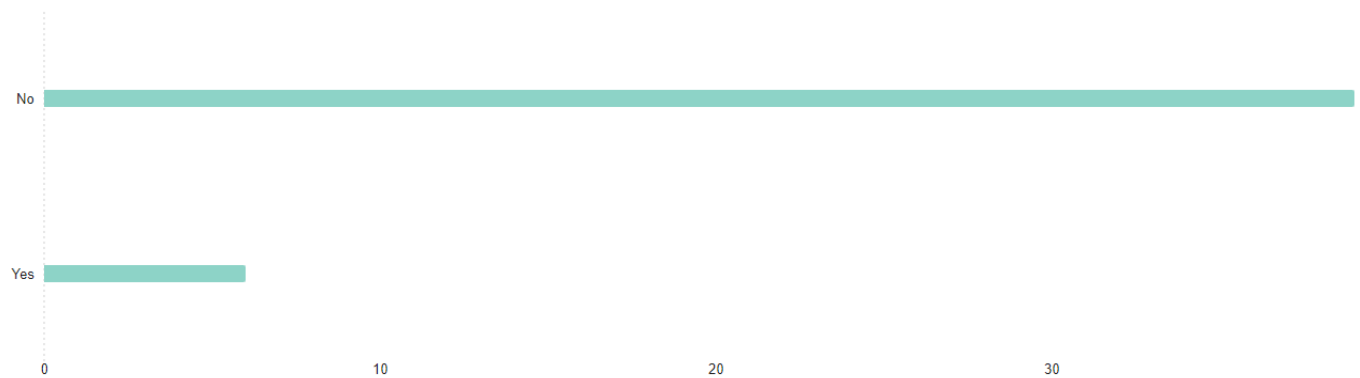
Q1 - Your major is in which of the following divisions? (check all that apply)

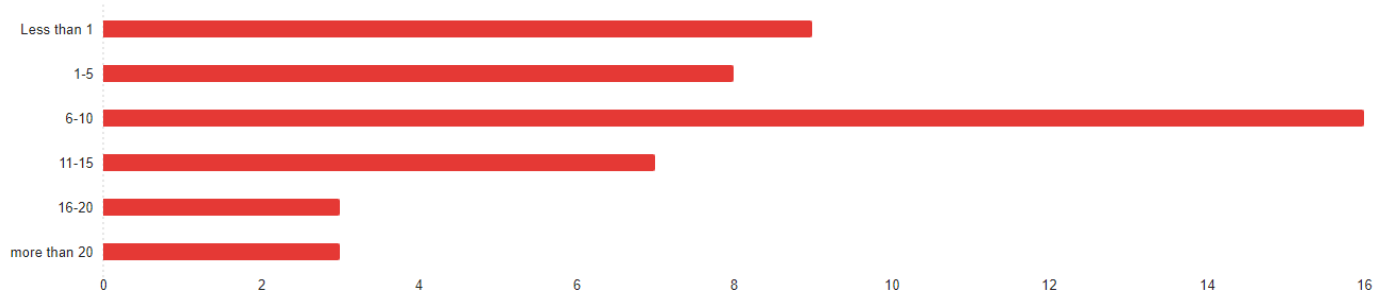

Q4 - On the whole, how important do you feel the Library was to your success at UCSB?

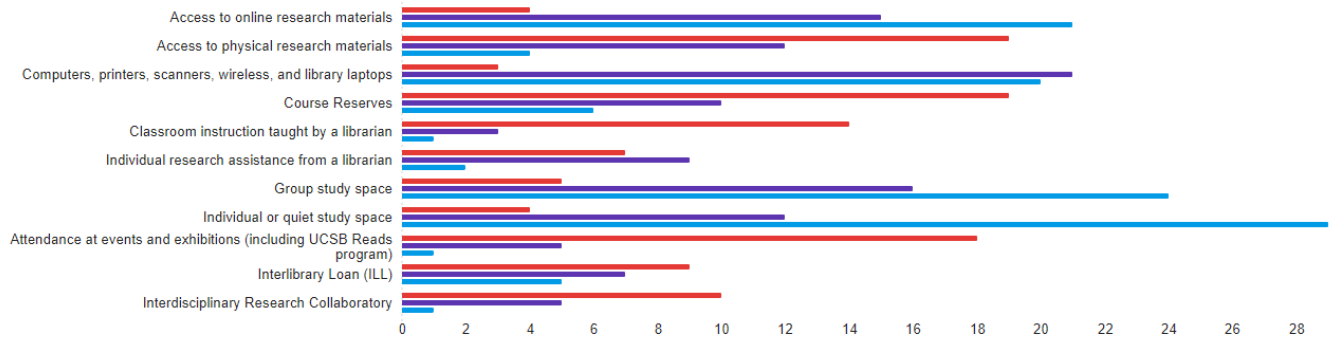
