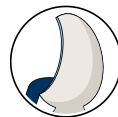
## GauchoPrint

You get 200 free prints per quarter with **GauchoPrint**. Send a print job from your device or a Library computer, and release it at printers on the first floor of the main Library.



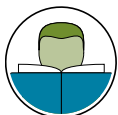
## Ask a Librarian
